Only a chief administration officer (principal, president, or highest-ranking official), or a school safety officer from a private postsecondary educational institution	Can be granted against someone who has been violent or made a credible threat of violence against 1 or more students; requires the threat be for act that would likely take place on campus	Clear and convincing evidence	Up to 3 years; may be renewed for up to 3 additional years.
